Mid-South Community College in West Memphis and Embry-Riddle
Aeronautical University-Worldwide (ERAU-W) have signed a transfer agreement that
allows MSCC students in three associate degree programs to move seamlessly into
equivalent bachelor's degree programs at the university.



Mid-South students who earn Associate of Applied Science degrees in Aviation Maintenance Technology, Advanced Manufacturing Technology, or Logistics & Supply Chain Technology can transfer into Aeronautics,

Technical Management, or Transportation programs at ERAU-W.

One of the advantages of the new partnership is that MSCC students will not need to leave the Memphis area or stop working to pursue their bachelor's degree. All the degrees are offered at the Memphis Campus of ERAU-W and delivered in a variety of instructional modes designed for the working adult.
