The 1,739 colleges, universities, and trade schools earning the most recent recognition demonstrate leading practices in the recruitment and retention of students with military experience.

"Mid-South Community College offers individualized attention, and we also provide very strong student support services, including free academic coaching," said Jeremy Reece, MSCC Director of Enrollment Services. "Our general education program is very successful with our students transferring credits to more than 140 top colleges and universities across the United States."
